She would make Halloween costumes for her grandchildren and would knit her husband, children and grandchildren sweaters. At the birth of each new grandchild, Judy would lovingly make for them a handmade quilt along with a knitted blanket and sweater. Quilting was another one of her favorite things to do. Her quilting won her awards at county fairs. She loved Duke University basketball and would not miss a game, she was one of their biggest fans. She worked for the Toledo City Schools for many years in the food service department.

Judy and Paul moved to Arizona and lived there over a decade before moving back to Waterville, Ohio to be with their family. Judy will be missed by all who loved her. She was a member of Our Lady of Lourdes Parish, Toledo, Ohio. A private family gathering to celebrate Judy's life will be held at the Lumen Christi Mausoleum at Resurrection Cemetery in Toledo, Ohio.

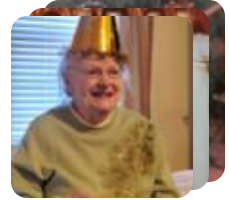
