Glenn Matthew Stamey, of Newark, Ohio, referred to by his family as "Denny", crossed over to Heaven on Sunday, February 5th, 2023, at the age of 80. Glenn fought the good fight against non-Hodgkin's Lymphoma for more than 25 years. Glenn was a patient when he passed away at the James Hospital, in Columbus, Ohio. Their care really is top notch, but Glenn's body was tired, and he was just ready to rest in God's arms.

Glenn was a devoted hard worker, who loved gardening; planting flowers; antiquing; and painting any item, wall, or object he could put paint on. He loved spending time with family and grandchildren; loved walking and riding his bike; and he especially loved God and attended church his entire life.
