Mark Steven Castleberry, age 66, went to be with the Lord and was reunited with his devoted wife, Alicia Morgan Castleberry, in Heaven on December 27, 2025.

He was born in Lansing, Michigan on January 24, 1959 and after exploring nearly every state in the U.S., he chose to settle in central Ohio, which he proudly called home. For 23 years, he worked at the Defense Supply Center in Columbus, where he was known as a dedicated and dependable employee, often putting in long hours, driven by a deep sense of duty.

A lifelong sports fan, Mark loved them all— especially baseball, football, basketball, and hockey— and could always be counted on to follow a game or talk stats. The O.S.U. 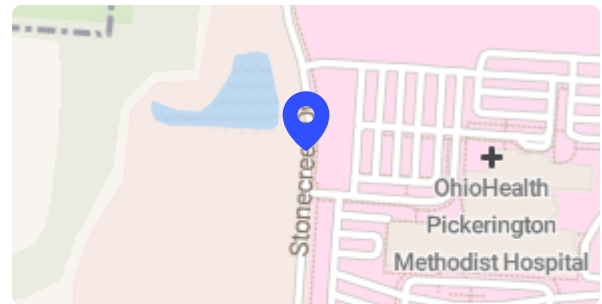
