**M**abel James Coventry, 94, of Powell, Ohio, passed away peacefully on Thursday, March 26, 2026. She was the beloved wife of the late James McKee III and a devoted mother to her three sons, Bruce (Robin), David (Debbie), and the late Brian (Chrissy). She was a proud grandmother to 12 grandchildren and great-grandmother to 5.

Mabel is survived by her sister, June Brubaker (the late Earl), and was preceded in death by her parents, James and Blanch Price, as well as her four sisters, Yvonne Brown (William), Shirley Lewis (Richard), Louise Bernstein, and Nedra Clark (Jerry).

She will be fondly remembered by her many friends in Buffalo, New York, and at the Abbington of Powell assisted living community, where her warmth and kindness touched all who knew her.

Mabel was born in Buffalo, New York, to James and Blanche Price, who had moved there from Alexandria, North Carolina. She was the third of six daughters and shared a lifelong bond with her sisters. She graduated from Kenmore High School and soon married Bruce Coventry of Derby, New York.
